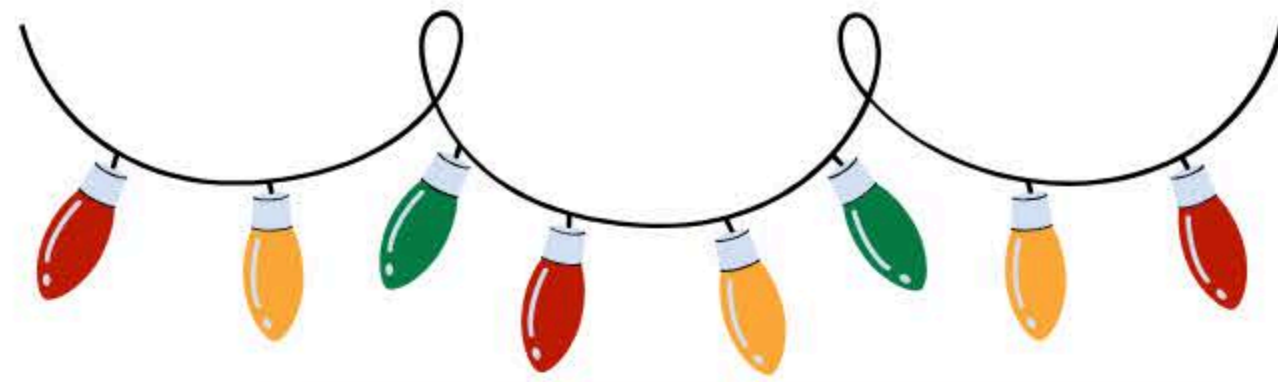

Ray our our Resident Artist and Biodiversity Coordinator has done an amazing job again this year with our decorations...

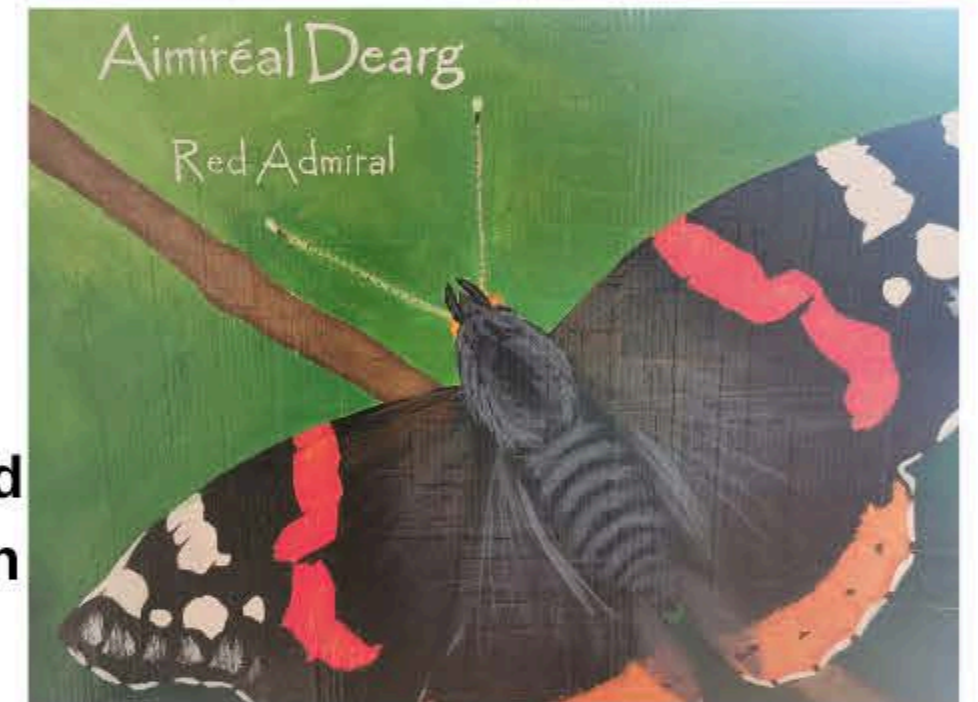
All materials used are either organic from natural sources such as branches, cones and foliage or recycled and rescued materials..



Thank you to Louth Swift Group who erected swift boxes at the Dolmen centre....

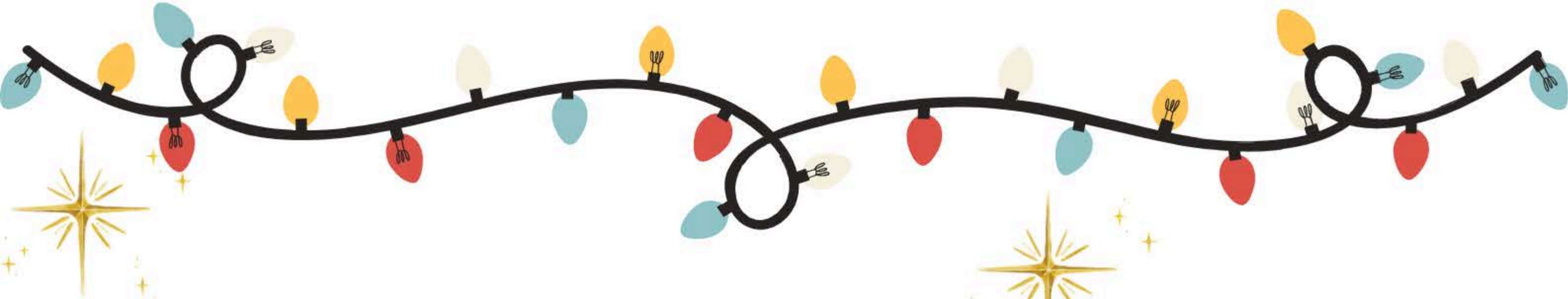
